As a paperless company, Milhaus needed its employees to have continuous access to its files if they were to remain successful. The phone system played an integral role in this success.

Milhaus calculated that if the phone system were to go down, it would cost tens of thousands of dollars a day just in employees' wages during downtime, not to mention any lost business that might result from this downtime.

The previous solution that Milhaus used to back up files to the cloud was not able to give them the recovery time objective (RTO) they needed to meet their SLAs. The company's doubled growth from 2015 to 2016 meant downtime would have a significant negative financial impact. The Milhaus IT team wanted to make sure whatever DRaaS provider they selected would be able to address three main deliverables: geo-diversity between the production and DR site; close proximity to their office for possible future production co-location; and the flexibility necessary for future growth.

After vetting a multitude of service providers around greater Indianapolis, Milhaus choose Online Tech's DRaaS offering powered by Zerto. The combination of Online Tech's strategic locations and collaborative team paired with the ease-of-use and aggressive SLAs of Zerto made the decision a no-brainer.

With Milhaus's old solution, a server failure meant rebuilding the VMs from scratch, which would be an extremely labor-intensive task.

Additionally, no other provider could support cross-hypervisor failover and failback which was important for Milhaus, which is currently standardized on Hyper-V.

Online Tech's portal layered over the Zerto solution gave Milhaus a reliable DR strategy that was easy to implement.
